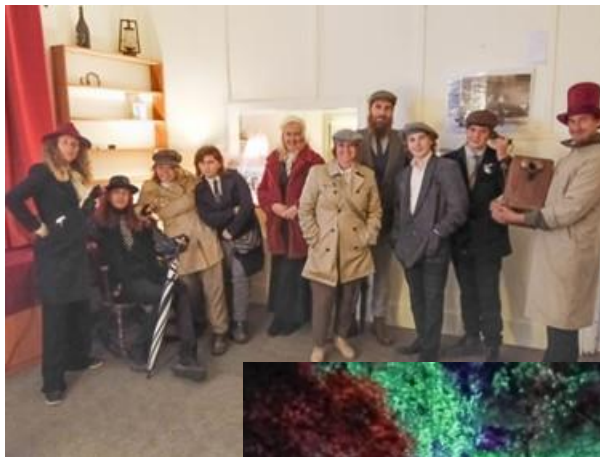
Four untimely deaths presented a window into the past, when forensics was not available as it is today. A much different time and investigations were quite limited.

We are extremely grateful to the Yarra Ranges Council for funding the event so that everyone could enjoy a free evening out and learn more about Millgrove.

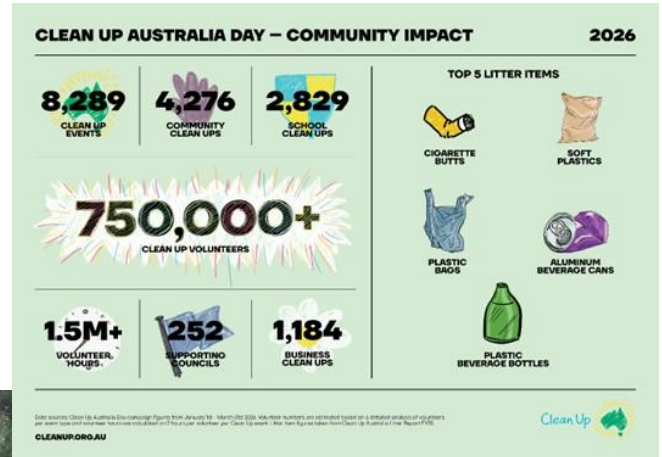
AMAZING MILLGROVE ANZAC DAY CEREMONY
