Below are some of the draft plans of how the site could look once fully established.

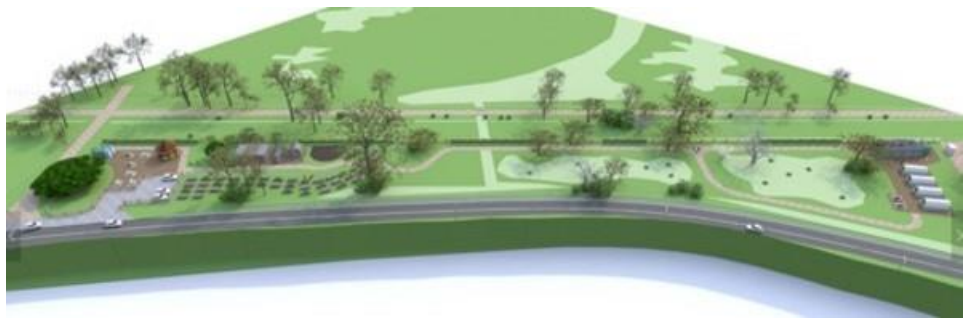
YOUTH HANG OUT TECH SESSIONS
